Interested speakers are invited to submit an abstract (~300 words) describing the main ideas of their presentation. Abstracts should focus on technical/managerial classifications, R&D, new technologies or recent project/case studies. Joint presentations between pipeline operators and technology providers are welcome.

Each speaker gets a presentation time of 20 minutes. All presentations is made available online for the conference attendees. *Speakers get 50% discount off conference fee.* Papers are not required.
