Reservoir & Production Management
Stavanger, 23 – 24 October 2018

The Norwegian Petroleum Society (NPF) is once again hosting its traditional two-day Reservoir & Production Management Conference in Stavanger. The conference is the result of merging the “Field Reservoir Management Conference” and the “Business Opportunities in Mature Fields Conference” and is a popular meeting and knowledge-sharing event for the Norwegian reservoir and production industry.

The Reservoir & Production Management Conference will cover strategy and business oriented topics. The aim is to illustrate how improved reservoir and production management is a part of the solution to the economic challenges that our industry is facing.

Field examples, updates on recent achievements, changes and new developments on the Norwegian Continental Shelf will be an important part of the conference, and invited speakers will also share some highlights from outside Norway.

With this in mind, we encourage companies and potential conference participants to submit an abstract for this year's conference. The topics covered under this theme will be:

- Business Environment, what's needed to keep the Norwegian oil production competitive in the global oil market
- Cost Effective Field Development and Operation
- IOR / EOR / new technology, and application on both green and brown fields
- Challenging reservoirs (containment, tight, HPHT etc.)
- Monitoring / 4D seismic / field instrumentation / digitalization

Abstract DEADLINE - EXTENDED: 25 May 2018

Interested speakers are invited to submit an abstract (~300 words) describing the main ideas of their presentation. Abstracts should focus on technical/managerial classifications, R&D, new technologies or recent project/case studies. Joint presentations between reservoir/production operators and technology providers are welcome.

Each speaker gets a presentation time of 20 minutes. All presentations will be made available online for the conference attendees. Speakers get 50% discount off conference fee. Papers are not required.
